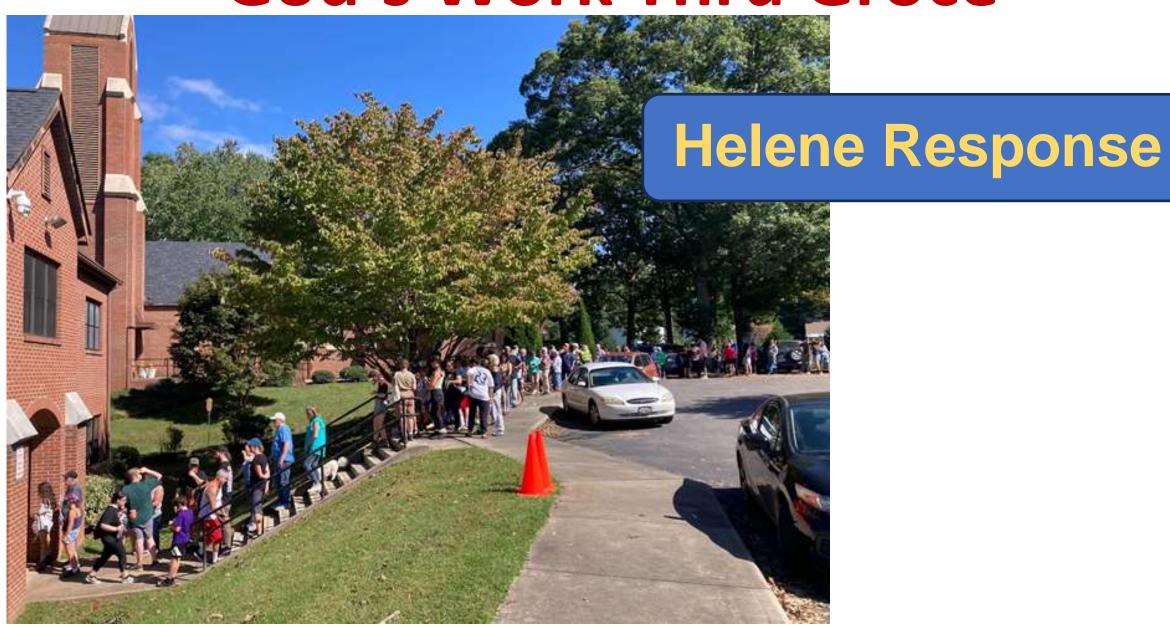

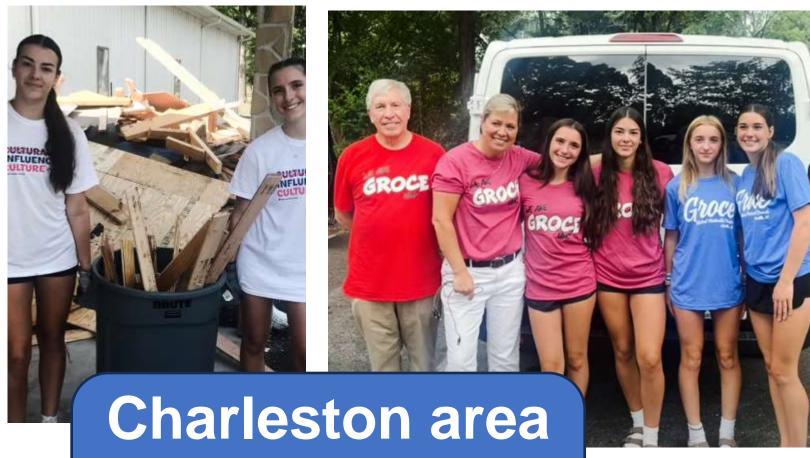

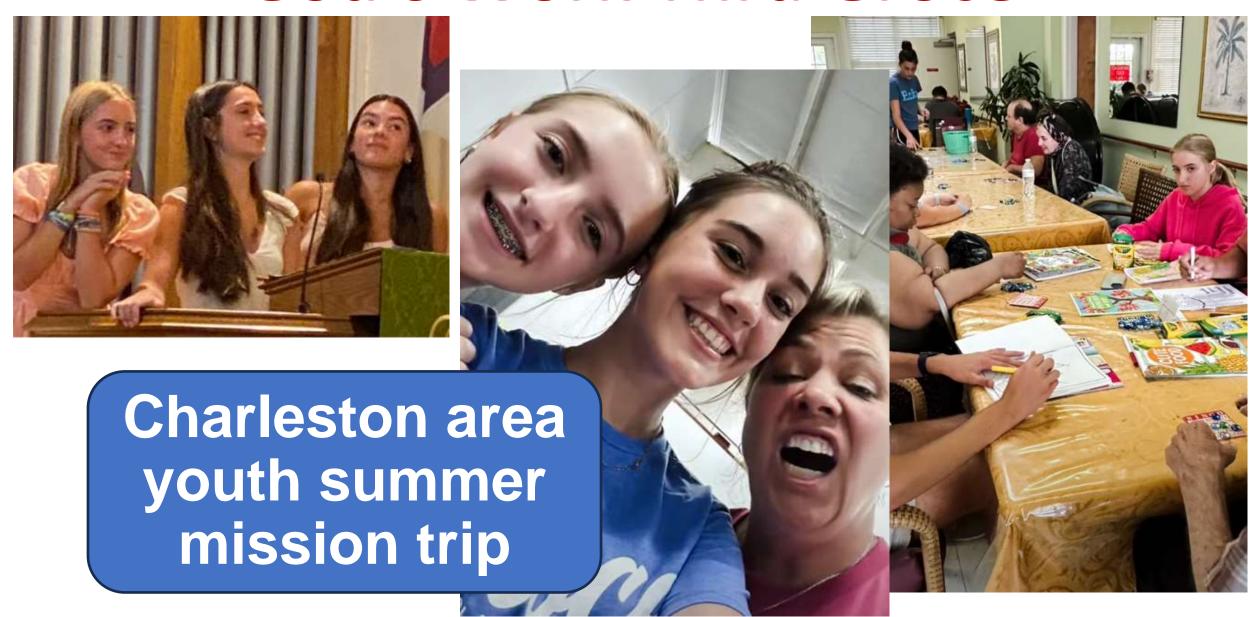

2025, and Beyond, Budget & Ministry Challenge

- Apportionments
- Inflation
- Previous Major Budget Cuts

Apportionments

- Contributes to the global, conference & district mission of the UMC
- Groce's apportionment is typically about \$30,000
- For 2022, 2023 and 2024 Groce paid 17% to 30% of its apportionment
- Groce last paid full apportionments in 2019

Inflation

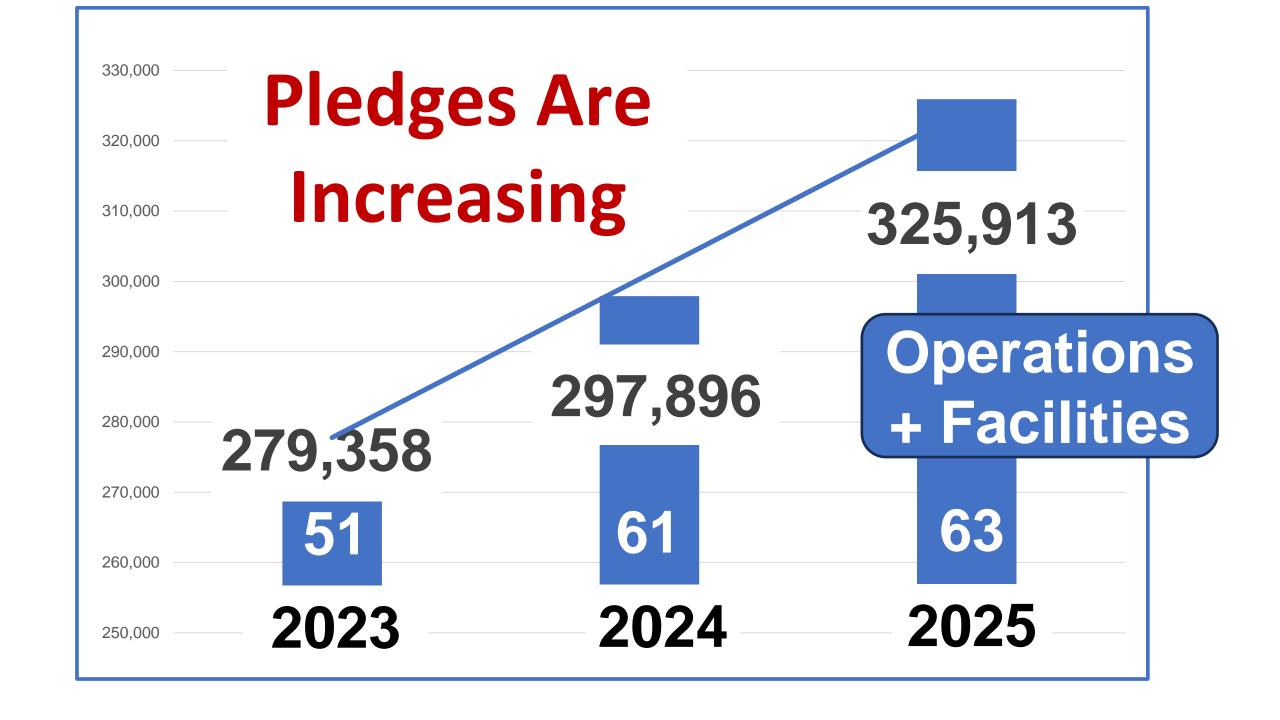
- Insurance increased \$8,000
- Incremental increases across other budget areas
- Great efforts by staff, Will as Trustees
 Chair, and others to control expenses

Previous Budget Cuts

- Elimination of associate pastor position in 2022 affected family, youth and children's programs
- Staff hours reduced to control expenses which impacts support for ministry teams & programs

Financial Stewardship Campaign Results

- Pledges & pledged amount increased
- Within \$7,000 of a balancedbudget, <u>BUT</u> it is dependent on special offerings to pay apportionments
- Within \$26,300 of a balanced budget if pledges are used to pay for apportionments

2025 Budget – FACILITIES FUND

We can no longer borrow money due to the present loans and bank restrictions on making loans to churches

So a healthy reserve is critical to keep the facilities usable
